Dear Prospective Preschool/Daycare Family,

We believe that our preschool and daycare can offer your child a quality, safe and Christ-centered environment. The love of Jesus is shared every day, as we care for and educate young children. We teach the children about letters and their sounds, numbers and math activities, computers, science experiments, books, and music and art through activities that are challenging and exciting. We work hard to have each child ready for Kindergarten in a fun, faith-filled and nurturing atmosphere.

Daycare is offered before and after preschool, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(If a child is enrolled in full-time daycare, they will also be automatically enrolled in preschool or Pre-K classes **for no additional price.**)

We have the following options for Daycare:

- Full-Time Daycare (24 or more hours per week)
- Part-Time Daycare (less than 24 hours per week)

We have the following options for classes:

MORNING from 8:30-11:00:

- Two & Three-year-old **Preschool**--Tuesday & Thursday
(Children do not need to be potty trained.)
- Three & Four-year-old **Preschool**--Monday, Wednesday, Friday
(Children enrolled in this class should be 3 years old by September 1.)
- Four & Five-year-old **One-Half-Day PreKindergarten**—Monday thru Friday
(Children enrolled in this class should be 4 Years old by September 1.)

AFTERNOON from 12:30-3:00:

- Four & Five-year-old **One-Half-Day PreKindergarten**—Monday thru Friday
(Children enrolled in this class should be 4 years old by September 1.)

FULL-DAY from 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.:

- Four & Five-year-old **PreKindergarten**—Monday thru Friday
(Children enrolled in this class should be 4 years old by September 1.)
This option is actually a combination of the morning and afternoon Pre-K classes.
